History	In 2008 M. Thomas and Beatrice L. Moore established an endowed scholarship fund the Catholic Community Foundation.
Purpose	To provide scholarships to students in financial need attending Catholic elementary schools in the Diocese of Cleveland.
Awards	Four annual \$500 scholarships will be awarded.
Who is Eligible	Catholic elementary school students currently in grades 1 through 7 who will be entering grades 2 through 8.
Criteria	<u>Financial</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The family will fill out a FACTS application <u>Merit</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scholastic achievement in accordance with the student's potential• Involvement of student in school life• Positive character traits
Letter	The parent/guardian and/or the student is required to write a letter (one-page maximum in length) stating why he/she believes the student fulfills the merit requirements.
Nominations	Each elementary principal is asked to review his/her student selected based upon the criteria stated above. Principals' can submit up to four applications to the OCFE.
Review/Awards	The Grants Administration Office of the OCFE will review the nominations and will have the final approval of the recipients
Timeline	March 15, 2018 - Students must return their completed applications with letters, to their principal.
